Additional Considerations

What? Construction and some land disturbing activities within shoreland land activities now require Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Plans to be approved by the Marquette County Land and Water Conservation Department.

Why? Sediment is the largest pollutant of Wisconsin's lakes and streams. Construction and land disturbing activities expose large amounts of bare soil to erosion. In shoreland areas, this eroded soil poses a great threat to the nearby water resources. Alterations of the landscape and increases in impervious surfaces aslo affect runoff. They may cause water to move faster and in larger quantities, force it to go where it had not gone previously, and prevent runoff from soaking into the ground.

Who? Me? Yes, if you are responsible for disturbing land - that is, exposing soil - <u>in any of the following ways</u>: You are constructing a structure within 1,000 feet of the ordinary high water mark of a navigable lake, pond, or flowage, or within 300 feet of the ordinary high water mark of a navigable river or stream.

You are working greater than 300 feet from the ordinary high water mark and exceed 10,000 square feet in area.

You are working within 75-300 feet of the ordinary high water mark and exceed 1,000 square feet in area.

You are working within 35-75 feet of the ordinary high water mark and exceed 500 square feet in area.

You are working on a parcel that required a State approved subdivision plan.

What do I have to do? You are required to have Erosion Control and Stormwater Management Plans Approved by the Marquette County Land and Water Conservation Department. The plan will need to demonstrate erosion control activities that will be used on your site. These controls are typically easy and relatively inexpensive, and can be as simple as installing a silt fence on the downslope side of the disturbance. At the time of your Erosion Control Plan approval, the Land and Water Conservation Department will also determine if a Stormwater Management Plan is necessary.

And What if I don't care? If you don't submit an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Plan for approval, you will not receive a permit, it is as simple as that. If you do have an Erosion Control/Stormwater Management Plan approved, but do not follow it, your permit will be revoked and you will be fined.
