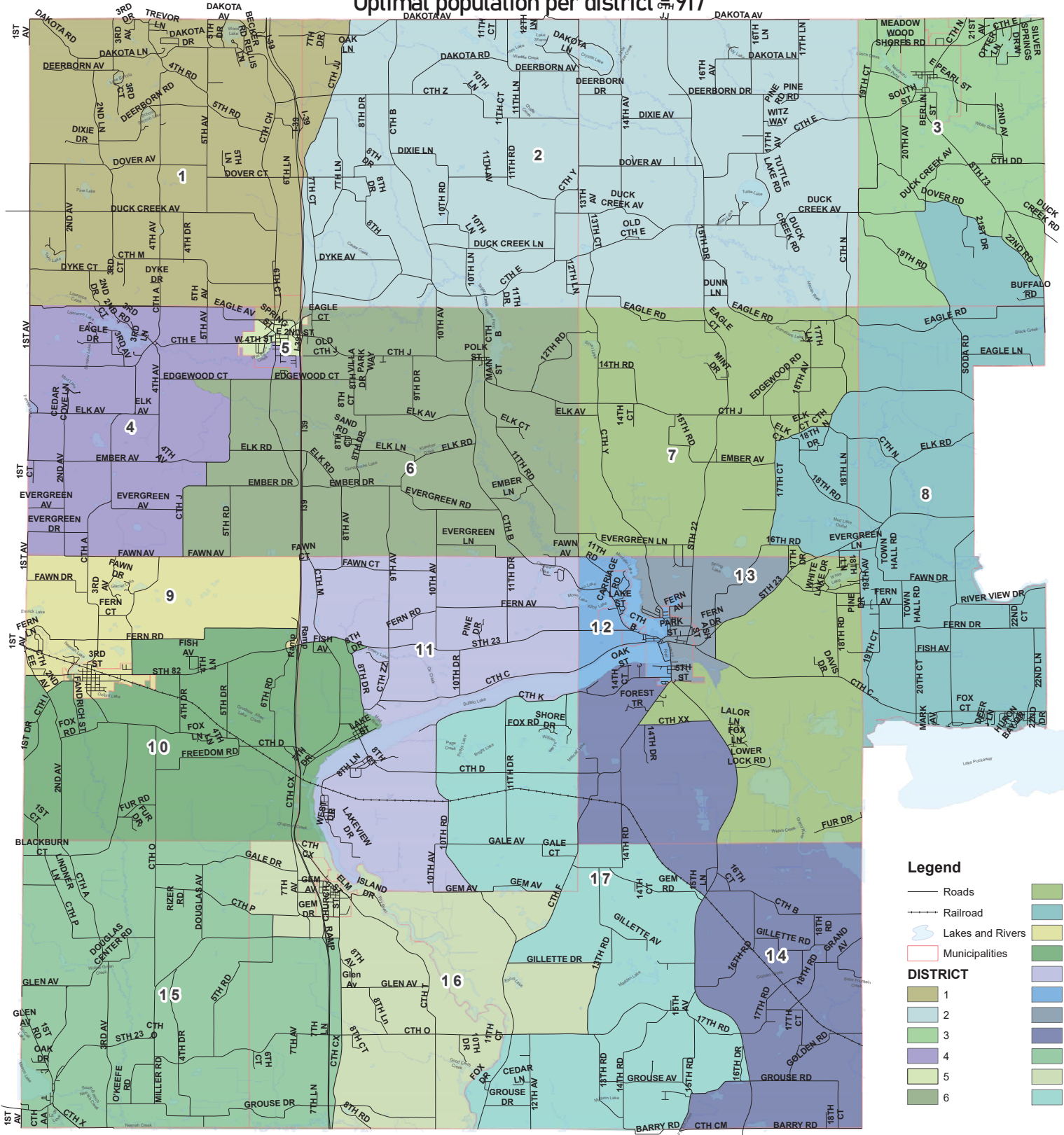


Marquette County Supervisory Plan 3.60%

The entire Town of Springfield and WARD 1 Town of Newton beginning at the intersection of West line Town of Newton and Dover Court, north thereof; West of 7th Court and County Trunk Highway JJ. Ward 3 Village of Westfield beginning at the intersection of W Pioneer Park Rd and Village Limits; Eastward to Spring St, thence southeasterly to Monroe St; thence northward to W Pioneer Park Rd; Eastward along E Pioneer Park Rd to the Westfield Creek; Northeasterly along creek to the Village limits; thence north to along Village Limits to Northeast corner; thence westward to Northwest corner of Village limits; thence South to the intersection of W Pioneer Park Rd.
