Meeting Minutes

May 9th, 2022, 12:30pm

Chairman Borzick called the meeting to order at 12:30pm.

Committee Members: Ken Borzick, Jeff Frazer, Dave Benson, Kathleen McGwin, & Karen Christensen. Others: Patrick Kilbey, Ron Barger, Keri Solis, Mary Walters.

Christensen, 2nd by Benson, motion to approve Agenda. **Motion Carried.**

Benson, 2nd by McGwin, motion to approve the April 2022 Meeting Minutes. **Motion Carried.**

Kilbey gave Monthly Report. Wayside/Hwy. 22 Welcome sign was installed and discussion on payment was had. Lock Channel/Footbridge at Krakow is closed and unless plans are found showing footings are not connected to lock walls, DNR will now allow bridge to open.

Kilbey has been in contact with Ice Age Trail Alliance, and they will be repairing and replacing boardwalk and doing other trail base repairs on trail around Muir Park. Discussion followed.

Update was given on Natural Playgrounds and the ARPA request after ARPA Committee met last week. The Committee has approved one playground for Muir Park and also the design costs for all 3 playgrounds. The proposal has been forwarded to County Board for final approval this month. Discussion and questions were had on playgrounds and county properties.

Barger presented idea to install flush bathrooms with sanitation at Muir Park using ARPA Funding and possible other grants. Committee agreed the facilities are needed at Muir Park and discussed the heavy use of the park. Consensus was for Kilbey/Barger to keep investigating facilities and get a project cost estimate together to report back.

McGwin gave update on Ice Age Trail final planning for corridor through Marquette County. Final plan will be sent to National Park Service for approval. Once approved, trail can start to be built through County. Discussion followed on Ice Age opportunities in County and future.

McGwin reported last month that there were 480 unique/new visitors to the John Muir History Route App. Discussion followed on App usage and properties that it serves.

Committee reviewed April expenses.

Meeting adjourned by the Chairman.
