RESOLUTION FOR FULL-TIME CVSO ASSISTANT

WHEREAS, due to increased workloads to meet Marquette County veteran needs the Veterans Service Office has determined the need for a full-time Veterans Service Office Assistant, and

WHEREAS, the current part-time Veterans Service Assistant position remains unfilled, and education and certification requirements for the position dissuade many part-time applicants from applying, and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Board and Executive and Finance Committee have by majority vote recommended the position move from part-time to full-time, and

WHEREAS, funds needing to move the position from part-time to full-time are not currently budgeted for,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by a 3/4ths vote that the Marquette County Board approves moving the Veterans Service Office Assistant position from part-time to full-time, with start date no earlier than August 1st, 2022, with funds required to make this change coming from the General Fund in the amount of \$10,789.59.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$10,789.59 to be added to the current Veterans Department budget via transfer from the General Fund.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, which is part of the American Rescue Plan Act, has provided the County with funds ("ARPA Funds") to meet pandemic response needs and rebuild a stronger and more equitable economy as the County recovers from the pandemic, and allows the County flexibility to decide how best to use this funding to meet the needs of the County, and

WHEREAS, the Marquette County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 45-2021 on September 21, 2021, authorizing the creation of an Ad Hoc Committee for ARPA Funds with final authority given to the Marquette County Board of Supervisors, and

WHEREAS, the Ad Hoc ARPA Committee has reviewed applications for proposed uses of ARPA funds that were submitted by March 18, 2022, and

WHEREAS, from the submitted applications, the Ad Hoc ARPA Committee has recommended use of the ARPA Funds to the County Board, following projects totaling \$141,594, and

WHEREAS, the individual projects the Ad Hoc ARPA Committee has approved to forward for County Board approval are the following:

1. VFW Post 8718 (Westfield) \$1200 towards material costs for new food trailer used for fundraising.
2. VFW Post 8718 (Westfield) \$500 towards flags for Veteran's graves and Main Street.
3. Springfield Fun Runners 4-H Club - \$1500 for vinyl exhibit signs to be hung at the Marquette County Fair.
4. Marquette County Land and Water Conservation Department - \$25,500 for County-wide well water testing program to identify unsafe drinking water due to high levels of nitrates.
5. Marquette County Parks Department - \$100,000 for engineering for three natural playgrounds and construction costs for one natural playground to be placed at John Muir County Park.
6. Marquette County Treatment Court - \$12,894 to cover contract with Jim Webb, Treatment Court Specialist, for the remainder of 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Marquette County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the expenditure of ARPA funds to go to the identified projects and for Administration to oversee the disbursement of funds.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$141,594 to be dispersed accordingly and transferred via ARPA Funds Account.

External Requests

VFW Post 8718 (Westfield)

Was unable to fundraise due to no events in 2020.

1. **\$1200** to be put towards purchasing materials for new food trailer, building it ourselves to save money, expected cost of materials is \$6000.00. We currently have \$3000.00 set aside for this project. With grant and 2022 fundraisers we fully expect to purchase needed materials during summer/fall of 2022. Our goal is to have the new trailer completed prior to the 2023 fund raiser season.
2. **\$500** to purchase flags for graves and main street, to be purchased May 2022, full amount of purchase.

Vinyl Signs - \$1500

3. Funds for 15 various sized signs to cover all the exhibits that our 4-H members will be taking to the Marquette County Fair in 2022. The estimate was \$1,500 for the signs. Example - we will be able to hang larger signs by the dairy and beef because of the headers on the buildings would allow us to hang them. We plan to have smaller ones to be able to sit on top of the cages for poultry, rabbits, etc because the rafters are so high we wouldn't have anything to hang them from.

Currently data collected from various sources is difficult to find and is not in one spot to easily identify problem areas. This will allow the county to identify “hot spots” and investigate further.

Natural Playgrounds

\$100,000 total (\$20,000 planning and \$80,000 construction)
