Move to approve Resolutions 44-2023 through 47-2023.

Resolution 44-2023: If adopted, the Marquette County Board of Supervisors approves 17.61 acres owned by Steven and Faye Lentz, Section 14, Town of Harris will be rezoned to AG-3(4).

Resolution 45-2023: If adopted, the Marquette County Board of Supervisors approves 10 acres owned by Tamara Rodger, Section 25, Town of Westfield will be rezoned to AG-2 and 70 acres to the FPO District.

Resolution 46-2023: If adopted, the Marquette County Board of Supervisors approves the amendment to Marquette County Code of Ordinances- Chapter 1, Article VI, Register of Deeds Documentation Reception Time Cut Off -filing and recording to be advanced by one hour on all official business days and cut-off reception time to be advanced by two hours on the last official business day of the year.

Agenda item # 13 – Resolutions Subject to Separate Consideration

Resolution 48-2023: If adopted, the Marquette County Board of Supervisors approves the signing of the 2024-2025 collective bargaining agreement with the County Deputy Sheriff's Association – WPPA/LEER with 2% pay increases on Jan 1 (2024 and 2025) and July 1 (2024 and 2025), adjustment of the on-call wage to go from \$1.50 per hour to \$1.75 per hour effective January 1, 2024 and then to \$2.00 per hour effective January 1, 2025, language revisions and additions to articles regarding recognition, promotions, hours of work and overtime, new job classifications, vacations, saving clause, and K9 compensation.

Resolution 49-2023: If adopted, the Marquette County Board of Supervisors approves the 2024 budget document setting the total appropriations of \$32,005,394 to be offset by anticipated revenues of \$16,807,709, which includes \$1,472,026 for Sales Tax and further offset by \$1,695 from the General Fund balance. The resulting tax levy is \$15,195,991.

Resolution 50-2023: If adopted, the Marquette County Board of Supervisors approves Chapter 2, Rules of the County Board of the Code of Ordinances, will be amended to reflect changes as recommended by the Ad Hoc County Board Rules Committee. WHEREAS Chapter DHS 36.09 and Chapter DHS 45.56 (3) require a coordination committee that includes representatives from various county departments, including individuals who are responsible for mental health and substance use services, child welfare, economic support services, youth justice, service providers, school districts, community mental health and substance abuse advocates, consumers, family members and interested citizens; and

WHEREAS Chapter DHS 36 and Chapter DHS 45.56 (3) require that coordinating committee membership be made up of at least 33% consumers and 25% parents and that no more than one-third the total membership be county employees or service providers; and

WHEREAS it has been determined that it is in the best interest of both programs to combine the coordinating committees;

TENTATIVE AGREEMENT FOR RATIFICATION BETWEEN
MARQUETTE COUNTY
and
THE MARQUETTE COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION, WPPA/LEER
September 25, 2023

Article 1 – Recognition – Modify the first paragraph to read:

The County recognizes the Association as the sole and exclusive bargaining agent for all regular full-time and permanent part-time employees, Patrol Sergeants, Detective Sergeants, Traffic Patrol Officers. See Appendix A. Expressly excluded from the bargaining unit are the Sheriff, Chief Deputy, Captain, Lieutenant, supervisory, part-time and casual employees.

2. Article 7 – Promotions – Modify the first paragraph to read:

All bargaining unit employees, shall be eligible for all promotional for open positions within the bargaining unit. The Sheriff shall post notices of job vacancies so that all employees capable of performing the job shall have an opportunity to apply. Promotions shall go to the most qualified applicant. Seniority shall be a consideration.

3. Article 10 – Hours of Work and Overtime – Modify the first paragraph of section D – Call-in to read:

Call-In. When employees are called in ~~by the Sheriff or Chief Deputy~~ for emergency duty, or are required to come in to work for court duty or appearances which are not an extension of the employee's shift, employees shall receive a minimum guarantee of two (2) hours or actual time spent when in excess of two (2) hours, paid at the rate of one and one-half (1 ½) times their average hourly rate, or one and one-half (1 ½) hours off with pay for each hour worked. There shall be no pyramiding of overtime.

4. Article 10 - Hours of Work and Overtime – Modify paragraph D to read:

D. On-Call Status. While on call, the employee shall be paid ~~\$1.50~~ \$1.75 per hour effective January 1, 2024 and \$2.00 per hour effective January 1, 2025 for on call status provided the employee is in compliance with the rules established by the Sheriff.

5. Article 11 – Wage and New Job Classifications – Modify paragraph B as follow to eliminate the permissive language:

New Job Classifications. Wage rates for new job classifications in the bargaining unit created during the term of this Agreement shall be negotiated ~~prior to filling the new position.~~

6. Article 16 – Vacations - Modify the last paragraph to read:

Any employees who have quit, ~~been discharged or laid off before they have worked their full year,~~ shall be entitled to vacation pay earned on a pro rata basis, provided they have completed their first anniversary of employment. Any employee that has used, but not earned paid vacation shall reimburse the County with reimbursement including repayment from any wages due the employee.

7. Article 22 – Saving Clause – Modify to read:

If any Article or Section of this Agreement, or any addenda thereto shall be held invalid by operation of law, inoperable or held to be invalid by any tribunal of competent jurisdiction, or if compliance with or enforcement of any Article or Section shall be restrained by such tribunal, the remainder of this Agreement and addenda shall not be affected thereby, and the parties shall enter into immediate collective bargaining negotiations for the purpose of arriving at a mutually satisfactory replacement for such Article or Section.

8. K9 Compensation – Language to be added to implement current language and benefits associated with K9 responsibilities subject to drafting and agreement on language.

9. Article 26 - Duration – Modify to read:

This Agreement shall become effective as of January 1, ~~2021~~, 2024 and shall continue in full force and effect until December 31, ~~2023~~ 2025, and shall continue thereafter year to year, unless notice of termination is given by either party at least ninety (90) days prior to December 31 of any year thereafter. On or before September 1st of any year in which this Agreement is to be opened for negotiations, the Association shall present its bargaining requests to the County. The County shall present its counter-proposal to the Association by September 15th of that year. Negotiations shall commence not later than October 1st of that year.
