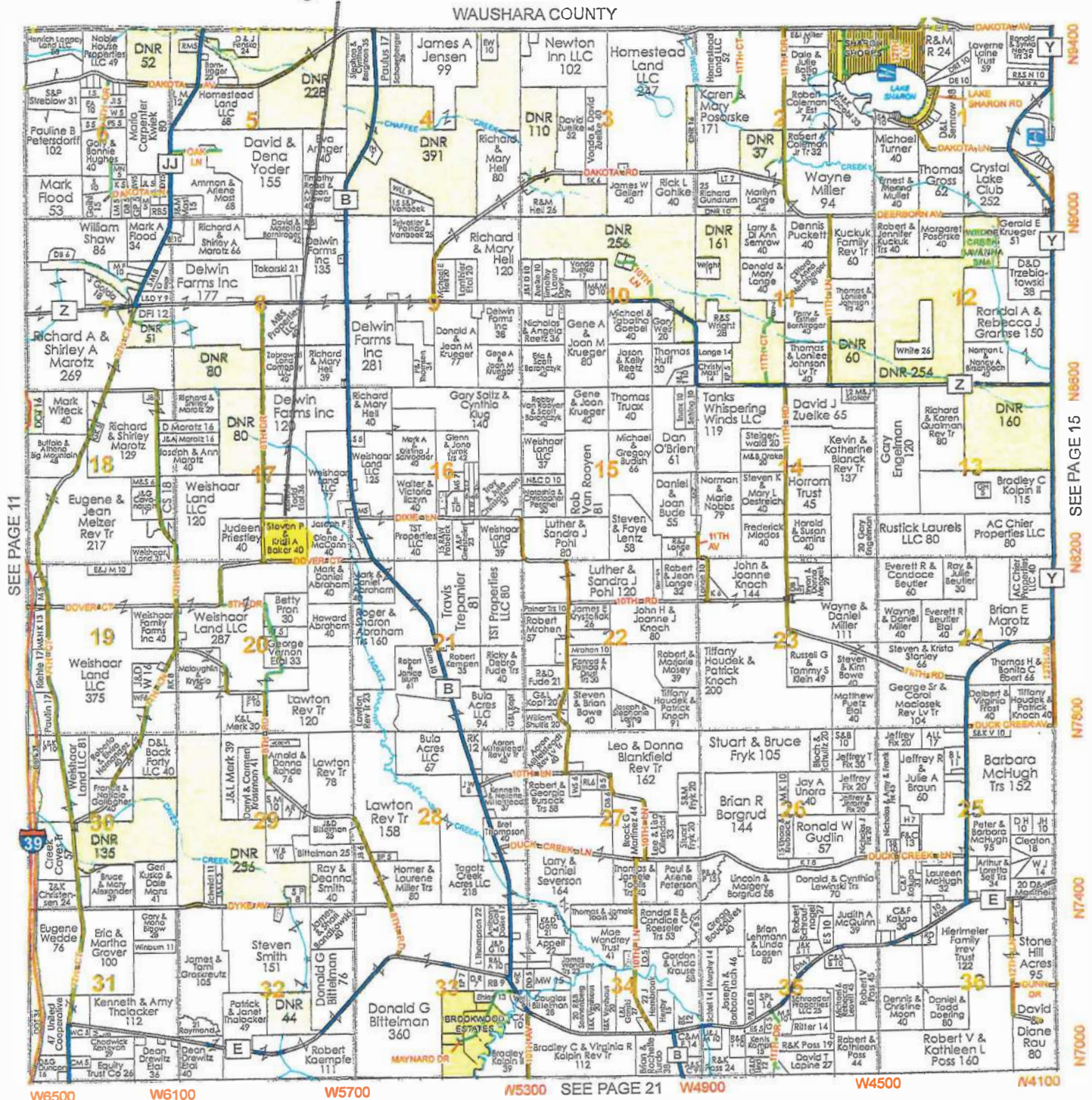

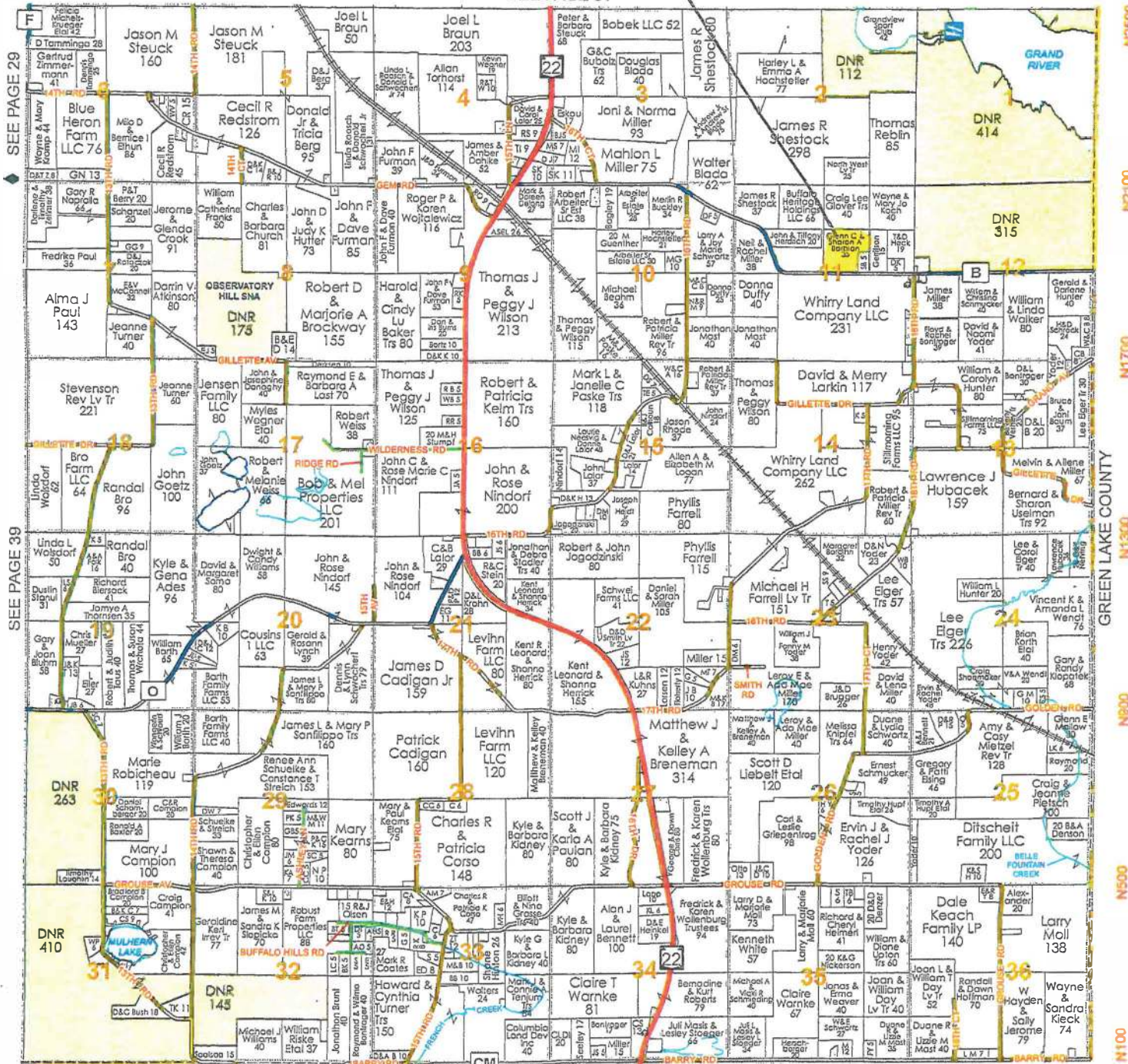

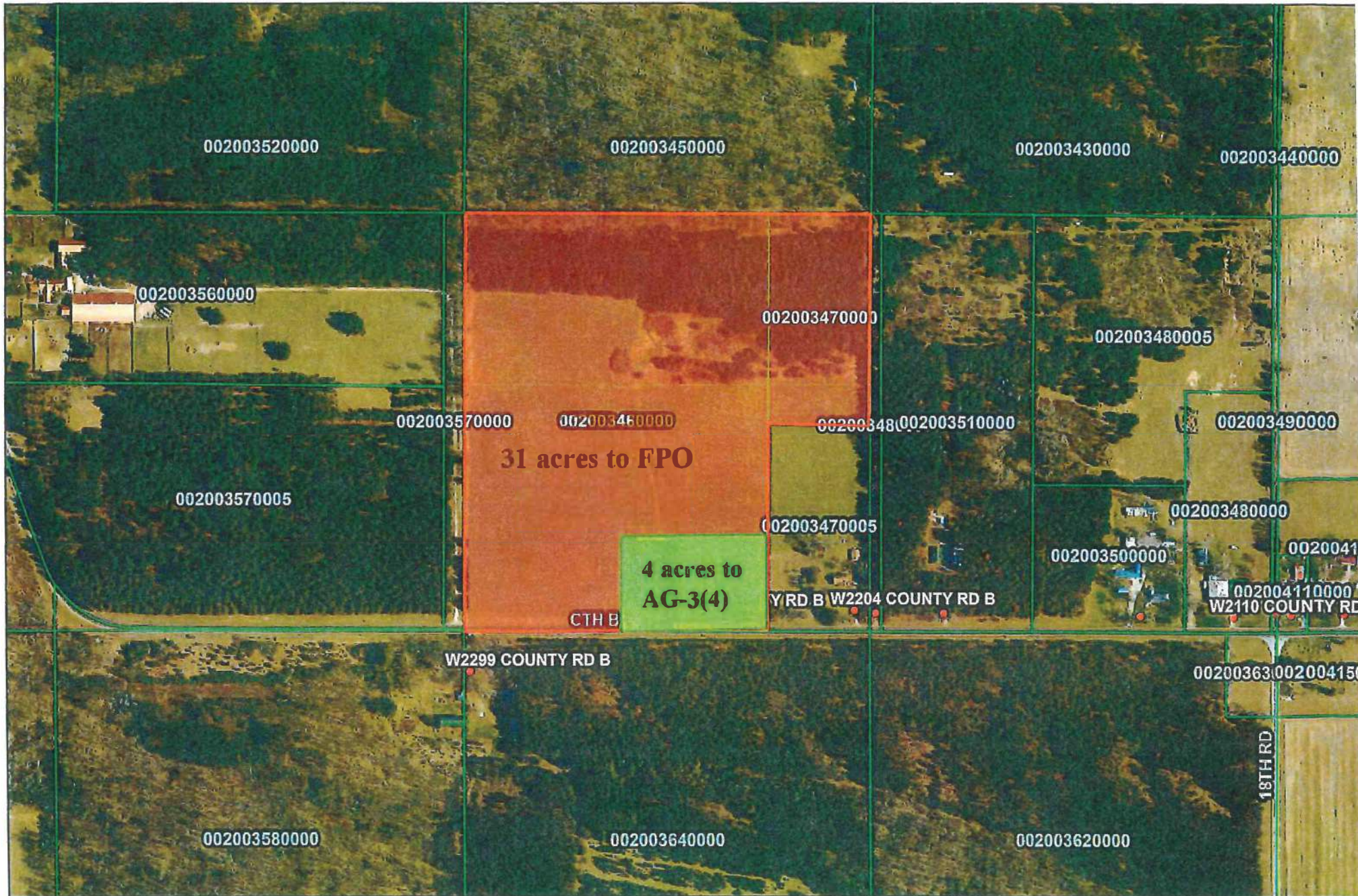

WHEREAS, the Marquette County Board of

regulated fees, and

setting forth the new Marquette County Fee Schedule and
rescinding all previously adopted fee schedules, and

WHEREAS, the Health Department has identified the
price of the Hepatitis B Vaccine has increased substantially,
therefore, the fee to administer the series needs to
adequately reflect the increase, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health and Executive &
Finance Committee have recommended to the County
Board of Supervisors that upon review the Health
Department Fees be updated to \$255 for the Hepatitis B
Vaccine 3-dose series, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the
Marquette County Board of Supervisors approves the
Hepatitis B Vaccine 3-dose series fee to be set at \$255 with
the adopted change to go into effect 2 weeks after
publication.
