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BOARD OF HEALTH**June 6th, 2023**

Board chairperson, Judi Nigbor called the Board of Health meeting to order at 9am. The following members were present. Judi Nigbor, Kathy Jo Locke, Barb Jordan, Dr. William Franks, Al Gibeaut, Mike Raddatz, and Kathleen McGwin. Also, present were Jayme Sopha, Health Officer/Director, Jessica Jungenberg, Environmental Specialists, Matt O'Connell, MIS Department, Jessica DeRosier, Public Health Nurse, Melissa Rose, Public Health Technician, Jack Nikolay, Student Intern, and Nicole Tank, Prevention Supervisor at Childrens Wi.

Members Absent: Ron Barger, County Administrator, and Nick Coenen.

Motion by Kathy Jo Locke, seconded by Al Gibeaut to approve the agenda as posted and handed out. Motion carried.

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH**COUNTY CONCERNS**

A written report for the month of April was presented by Jessica Jungenberg. The month of April included the following contacts: 11 contacts-rabies program, 3 quarantine orders and 3 released from quarantine, 0 well water tests and no radon testing kits, 0 lead contacts, and 20 housing contacts regarding complaints of a condemned dwelling placard being removed multiple times, large amounts of garbage in yards, no heat in a rental, and wanting information regarding bed bugs.

A written report for the month of May was presented by Jessica Jungenberg. The month of May included the following contacts: 9 contacts-rabies program, 4 quarantine orders and 3 released from quarantine. 2 well water tests, 0 radon testing kits, 0 lead contacts, and 10 housing contacts regarding complaints of large amounts of garbage piling up at some properties, horse manure on property lines, and reports of a dwelling that does not have water.

AGENT STATUS PROGRAM UPDATE

The month of April included 17 Marquette County inspections, 0 re-inspection, and 2 pre inspection. There were 5 Waushara County inspections, 2 pre inspections, and 0 Green Lake County inspections. One training was attended.

The month of May included 29 Marquette County inspections, 4 re-inspections, and 2 pre inspections. There were 5 Waushara County inspections, and 13 Green Lake County inspections. One training was attended.

OLD BUSINESS

NARCAN POLICY UPDATE

Jayne discussed that the changes from the last Board of Health meeting have been added/updated. The board agreed with the updated verbiage but asked that the policy also include an incident report form to be filled out and submitted HR in the event of emergency Narcan use by county employees.

NEW BUSINESS

GYT CAMPAIGN- JESSICA DEROSIER

Jessica discussed that we got grant funding for the GYT (Get Yourself Tested) Campaign. It's a campaign geared towards at risk populations which include those without healthcare and individuals between 15-24 years old. We plan on providing free STI testing and treatment for Gonorrhea and Chlamydia. We will also be providing dual protection kits that provide condoms, emergency contraception, resources and education materials. The hopes are to have some after hours events at the Health Department, as well as some different locations within Marquette County to reach more of our community.

CHILDREN'S WISCONSIN HOME VISITING REPORT- NICOLE TANKS

Nicole introduced herself to the Board of Health, she is a Prevention Supervisor with Childrens Wisconsin for twelve years. She went over with the board what programs they offer to Marquette County residents. Which are: The home visiting (Pregnant and Birth to one year), Parenting classes (Birth to 10 years), Parenting for Success (Parenting classes held in Marquette County Jail), Play & Learn Groups (Birth to 6 years held in Montello & Westfield), Family matters/newsletter (Three times a year), Warmlines (Connection to non-emergency help with parenting), Family events (Community events), Family forums (Virtual or in person about important parenting topics), and Help me grow (Birth to 60 months, developmental screenings).

APPROVAL OF HEPATITIS B VACCINE FEE INCREASE

Jayne discussed that we purchase our own Hepatitis B Vaccine, and it is not State Funded. When the price goes up, we need to increase our prices for giving the vaccine. We were charging \$175 but are asking to increase it to \$210 to cover the new price, plus a nominal fee for syringes, alcohol swabs, and the nurse's time.

Motion by Kathleen McGwin, seconded by Mike Raddatz to approve the Hepatitis B Vaccine fee increase. Motion carried.

BUDGET REPORT FROM ADMINISTRATION – Budget Report from Administration through the month of March was presented to the Board of Health members to review. No concerns.

REVIEW DEPARTMENT BILLS – A voucher of expenses for the month of May 2023, was provided for the Board of Health members to review.

Kathleen McGwin discussed how Waushara County is doing a Walk-The-Waush, and asked if there were any related efforts going on in Marquette.

Jayme discussed how Kathleen reached out to see if we do anything with Farmers Mental Health. So we have been posting on our facebook page and doing Farmers Friday posts so that even if farmers don't see them, their families or friends could see it and know about the help that is out there.

Jayme also mentioned that the AV upgrade is done at the Health Department and that the Board of Health meetings will be held at the Health Department Conference Room from now on.
