6. Committee Reviewed Vouchers as Presented
7. Clerk of Circuit Court Shari Rudolph reported no new updates. DA's Office Manager Emily Krueger reported the DA application deadline has been extended until April 7th by the Governor's Office. Emergency Management Director Lt. Aaron Williams reported we could be experiencing some poor weather conditions today. He is working with Brian Trebiatowski regarding spring weather and possible flooding. Medical Examiner Tom Wastart reported we're over 46 cases in Marquette County and over 100 total with Marquette County and Green Lake County for 2023. Discussion regarding Marquette County and Green Lake County Intergovernmental Agreement. A special meeting will be called if Green Lake County contacts Marquette County with updated contract.
8. EMS Director Rob Lulling reported call volume is at 127 calls for March. Rob reported there was a resignation in January and noted there are several staff currently out on leave for medical reasons, which is leading to overtime. Will be doing interviews shortly. Cots are up for replacement. Cots are \$27,000/piece and county needs 4- county was granted \$19,000 and received a donation of \$33,000. Rob reported Wisconsin State Stroke Coalition awarded Marquette County EMS for being in top 3% for stroke response. Ron Barger reported the EMS Union will be choosing new representation. More information to follow. New ambulance will arrive in May.
9. Sheriff Joe Konrath reported he has one vacancy in dispatch/jail. Recent hire made for patrol. Continuity of Operations Plan has been completed by Jail Captain Kari Tomlin. A tabletop exercise will be taking place soon.
10. Ron Barger reported the Marquette County and Green Lake County Intergovernmental Agreement has been extended through April with 2022 fees still being used.
