3. Motion to approve the July 5, 2023 minutes by Mary Walters and seconded by Ken Borzick. Motion carried.
4. Reports of official meetings held in the prior month- None

6. Committee Reviewed Vouchers as Presented- None
7. Clerk of Circuit Court Shari Rudolph reported there are no new updates. 2024 Clerk of Circuit Court Budget presented. Moved by Ken Borzick and seconded by Al Gibeaut to approve and forward 2024 Clerk of Circuit Court budget to Executive & Finance Committee. Motion carried.
DA's Office Manager Emily Krueger reported there are no new updates. Moved by Al Gibeaut and seconded by Kathy Jo Locke to approve and forward 2024 District Attorney budget to Executive & Finance Committee. Motion carried.
8. Emergency Management Director Lt. Aaron Williams reported they did 2 tabletop exercises in July-one was a mass causality exercise with EM, MASO, Fire Dept., and EMS, the other was a joint county COOP plan exercise. EM 2024 Budget was presented. Moved by Mary Walters and seconded by Ken Borzick to approve and forward 2024 Emergency Management budget to Executive & Finance Committee. Motion carried.
Medical Examiner Tom Wastart reported 90 deaths in Marquette County. Ron noted GL County has a new Finance Director and they will report to Ron what Marquette County should put into 2024 ME Budget.
9. EMS Director Rob Lulling reported 190 calls in July. Other stats are on SharePoint. New cots to be delivered on Monday, which were purchased through grants and donations. Rob has been applying for several grants. EMS staff taught CPR to 400 people in 2023. Waushara sent a letter thanking Marquette County EMS for their assistance in large fire. EMS 2024 Budget was presented. Moved by Al Gibeaut and seconded by Mary Walters to approve and forward 2024 EMS budget to Executive & Finance Committee. Motion carried.
10. Sheriff Joe Konrath reported he has submitted the PSAP grant. If awarded the county has 10% match of \$54,348. National Night Out with EMS and Fire organized by Captain

Tomlin was a success. Received the DOC approval letter for the Sallyport addition. Body worn cams began use August 8th. Sheriff's Office 2024 Budget presented. Moved by Mary Walters and seconded by Al Gibeaut to approve and forward 2024 Sheriff's Office budget to the Executive & Finance Committee. Motion carried.

11. CVSO Kris Bergh reported Sheriff Konrath was awarded the Edward J. Ormsby Law and Order Award.
