1. The Marquette County Property Committee meeting was called to order at 12:30 p.m. by Committee Chairperson Lance Achterberg.

2. Motion by Dave Benson and seconded by Mary Walters to approve agenda as presented. Motion carried.
3. Motion by Mary Walters and seconded by Dave Benson to approve the minutes of the September 3, 2024. Motion carried.

7. Treasurer Jody Myers reported she and Corp Counsel Natalie Bussan worked on a Tax Deed Fee Ordinance Schedule. Natalie presented a fee schedule and reported the options would be the county charge: a flat fee per tax deed, time tracking, or use the presented option. Moved by Mary Walters and seconded by Dave Benson to approve tax deed fee schedule with condition that the wage average update be applied to all fees and to provide tax fee schedule to all individuals going through the tax deed process. Motion carried.
8. B&G Superintendent Paul Van Treeck reported the final blocks of the retaining wall will be constructed today, with concrete, curb, and gutter to be completed next week. The money for project coming from deferred maintenance account and insurance money. Paul reported the Lead Custodian Position is currently open for the first time in 27 years and is being reevaluated. The position has become more grounds heavy. The position will be brought back around January or so, to see how the department will move forward. Paul shared his monthly report noting the radio tower shelters are weatherproofed, highway shop roof will be completed this week, dispatch plumbing repair complete, and salt shed light fixture installation complete. Paul shared information and photos of the Ice Age Trail Alliance and Boardwalk building update. Paul also shared the B&G work order summary.
