

What is Comprehensive Community Services (CCS)?

CCS is a voluntary, team based, consumer driven recovery program for children and adults living with mental health or substance use issues. Services are community based and individualized to meet each consumer's unique needs for rehabilitation and recovery within a team approach.

A recovery team is chosen by the consumer and can include: the consumer, family members, friends, mental health/substance use professionals, and other individuals the consumer would like to have. The recovery team is to support the consumer during the recovery process and reach identified goals.

Who is eligible for CCS?

CCS is available to children and adults who meet the following criteria:

- Marquette County resident
- Eligible for Badgercare or another Medicaid program
- Have a diagnosed mental health and/or substance use disorder
- Are determined to need to psychosocial rehabilitation services.

What services can CCS provide?

CCS can provide a wide array of Medicaid funded services. Some of these services include:

- Assessment and Recovery Planning
- Service Facilitation
- Psychotherapy
- Substance Use Counseling
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation
- Employment Related Skills Training
- Individual and Family Psychoeducation
- Medication Management
- Psychiatric Care
- Wellness Management

Guiding Principles

- ❖ Consumers have a voice in decisions that affect them and their path of recovery
- ❖ Consumers' recovery plan will reflect their strengths, needs, abilities, talents, and resiliency.
- ❖ Recovery is accomplished in the community and together consumers and providers develop goals.
- ❖ Each consumer's values, beliefs, customs, and culture will be acknowledged and respected.

Your Consumer Rights

- A choice in the selection of recovery team members
- Specific, complete, and accurate information about services
- Confidential services and records.
- A fair hearing under DHS 104.01(5) for Medical Assistance applicants.

How Do I apply?

Often, a consumer is referred to the program by a school, a therapist, a doctor, or another professional they are working with. Anyone interested in CCS can apply by completing an application to the program. You can call Marquette County Human Services Clinical Services Unit and speak with a staff member about the program.

After an application is received, a CCS staff member will contact you to start the enrollment process. The staff member will complete an assessment and talk to you about your goals. You will receive assistance in identifying services, providers, and setting up appointments. The staff person will also assist you in creating your Recovery Team.
