A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN FOR THE MARQUETTE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE

WHEREAS, Marquette County is undertaking a 10-
year cycle update to its Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute Section
66.1001(4)(a), local governmental units, including counties,
are required to adopt written procedures designed to foster
public participation at every stage of the preparation or
amendment of a comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, a Public Participation Plan has been
drafted to ensure broad, effective, and meaningful public
engagement throughout the comprehensive planning
process; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Committee has
reviewed and recommended the approval of the Public
Participation Plan;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Marquette
County Board of Supervisors that the attached Public
Participation Plan is hereby approved and adopted to
govern public engagement for the Marquette County
Comprehensive Plan Update.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this policy shall
take effect immediately upon passage.

Marquette County 2040 Comprehensive Plan Update Public Participation Plan

Marquette County, WI is undergoing a 10-year update to the 2015 Comprehensive Plan. The update will adjust sections to improve organization, implementation, update statistics, and align with the recently completed Strategic Plan.

Public engagement will be a key driver in the update process. This document lists the methods that will be used for public participation as required by Wis. Stat. § 66.1001(4)(a). The following methods will foster participation and inform community members about plan updates.

1. Project Website

Marquettecounty2040.com will be the hub for engagement and project information. The website will allow users to review planning documents, project milestones, complete surveys, and learn about in-person engagement opportunities. The County's website will provide a link to the project website and information about it.

2. Surveys

Surveys will gather information from the Marquette County community. The surveys will allow people to answer questions about their vision, issues, and land use changes within the County. The surveys will be available on the project website and at the County Courthouse.

3. Public Open Houses

Two open house sessions will be held. The first open house is intended to spread awareness of the update and gather information about the community's vision. The second open house will share the draft plan and allow community members to provide comments and feedback. Both meetings will allow public comment and responses from the planning consultant and the County.

4. Public Hearing

A public hearing will be held before final adoption. The plan will be reviewed, and time will be provided for comments from community members. A Class 1 notice under ch. 985 will be published at least 30 days before the hearing.

5. Social Media

Facebook will be used to promote the project website, surveys, and participation opportunities as they are scheduled.

6. Planning and Zoning Committee Meetings

The planning consultant, Place Foundry, will attend two Planning and Zoning Committee meetings to provide project updates and answer questions.

7. Notice to Quarries

Wis. Stat. § 66.1001(4)(e) requires distributing notice to owners or leaseholders of properties in which extraction of nonmetallic mineral resources is permitted. The County will fulfill this requirement by distributing written notice via first-class mail to all applicable owners and leaseholders prior to the public hearing.

8. Written Comments

Throughout the update process, members of the public are encouraged to submit written comments regarding the Comprehensive Plan. Written comments may be submitted digitally via the project website, by email to jpotter@marquettecountywi.gov or by mail to 77 West Park Street, Room 104, Montello, WI 53949-9366. The County will review all written comments, acknowledge receipt, and provide responses either directly via written reply or by addressing the feedback provided during scheduled open houses and Planning and Zoning Committee meetings.

AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 99- FEES- OF THE MARQUETTE COUNTY ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Marquette County Board of
Supervisors adopted Resolution 30-2022 for the purpose of
establishing Chapter 99, a new central location for county
regulated fees, and

WHEREAS, the Marquette County Board of
Supervisors adopted Resolution 57-2022, adopting Exhibit A
setting forth the new Marquette County Fee Schedule and
rescinding all previously adopted fee schedules, and

WHEREAS, the Health Department has been
notified by distributors that the price of the high dose flu
vaccine has increased, therefore, the fee to administer the
high dose flu vaccine needs to adequately reflect the
increase, and

WHEREAS, the Health Department has identified
that the Foot Clinic visit fees have not been increased in 11
years, with an increased fee being necessary to reflect the
increased costs associated with goods and services, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health has recommended
to the County Board of Supervisors that upon review the
Health Department fees be updated to \$150 for the High
Dose Flu Vaccine and \$35 for all Foot Clinic visits, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the
Marquette County Board of Supervisors approves the High
Dose Flu Vaccine fee to be set at \$150, and the Foot Clinic
Visit fee to be set at \$35 with the adopted changes to go into
effect 2 weeks after publication.
